SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY

If there is any medical information you know of, we ask you to please indicate it on the medical release form. We carry these forms everywhere we go in case of an emergency. Also please send any medicine your students need in a ziploc bag with their name on the front with directions inside. We want you to be at ease leaving your child with us, so if we have left any questions unanswered, feel free to ask.

DRESS CODE

We want all students to feel comfortable and welcome at camp. In order for distractions to be minimized, dress code is a must! Our leaders will be responsible for making sure all students are dressed responsibly during the week. If a student's dress is inappropriate they will have to change. One piece bathing suits/tankinis are required and speedos are not allowed. Also, we ask that guys wear a shirt at all times unless at field games or water activities. Casual dress is appropriate for worship sessions. Overall, we require your students to be modest and respectful with their attire. Parents please check their luggage before they leave for camp.

"NO ISSUES POLICY"

We do not discipline; we send home. Every student will know the expectations and be expected to follow the rules at all times. Disobedience, disruption, or defiance to the rules will result in a trip home. If that is the case, the parent or guardian listed will be contacted to come pick up their child. This is important so that students can stay safe and remain focused on what God has for them. We will not allow students to dress inappropriately, so again we ask that parents review their luggage and double-check the guidelines given. We stand firm on this policy but do not foresee this to be an issue. With that said, we are not afraid to enforce it if needed.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What adults will be going? We will bring an entire team of pastors, church staff, a qualified medical person, and volunteer small group leaders who have been trained and background checked. We always try to bring about 1 adult for every 4-5 students.

Will my middle schooler be mixed with high schoolers? We try to separate them as much as possible: for example in small groups and rooming assignments. There will be some overlap at mealtime and during worship but we try to keep them separate for the most part with their age group and friends!

How will we get there? We have contracted a professional charter bus company to take us down and back in order to insure your students safety on the trip!

Will my student ever be on their own? The answer is no. They will have a team of small group leaders responsible for their small group at all times. They will not go to the beach, snack bar, worship, etc alone or without a leader, EVER!

Are there refunds? Unfortunately, we cannot offer refunds unless the event is cancelled altogether. This is why we try to plan and promote well in advance so you can plan accordingly.

WHAT DO MY STUDENTS NEED TO BRING?

- Fantastic attitude and desire to hear from the Lord.
- BIBLE, PEN, NOTEBOOK.
- Clothes for two days of field games and fun activities.
- Bathing suits. (see dress code)
- Appropriate clothes for worship.
- There will be 3 theme nights for our worship sessions. These will be announced via our social media platforms as camp nears. Be on the lookout!
- Sheets, blanket, pillow.
- Toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, washcloths, towels, etc.
- Sunscreen and beach towel.

NOT TO BRING

- Spaghetti Straps, small tank tops, etc.
- Tight fitting clothing.
- Shorts, if fingertips are touching skin, they are too short.
- No two piece or revealing bathing suits are allowed.
- Speedos.
- Video Games.
- Tobacco, vape, drugs, alcohol, or weapons.
- Fireworks.
- Water balloons.
- Clothing with questionable sayings.

COST

We have a payment system we hope will help you plan and benefit you the sooner you register your student. Registration will lock in your price. The price increases are as follows...
